ABOUT THE ORCHESTRA AND THE PROJECT

WBYO Accelerando is an EU-supported project to advance the Western Balkans Youth Orchestra (WBYO) development.

The Western Balkans Youth Orchestra (WBYO) is a groundbreaking initiative establishing an orchestra of young professionals from the entire Western Balkans. The Orchestra was founded in 2019 by Desar Sulejmani, the Albanian born German Conductor, Pianist and Visionary.

His idea behind the orchestra is to unite the region's youth, breaking down barriers and fostering long-lasting peace, featuring genres from classical to pop and rock music.

The platform for young musicians will work across national, ethnic, religious, and cultural divides, contributing to ongoing cross-border and interethnic cooperation.

For the summer project 2023, called "WB Go Dance" we opened the rows for musicians from 15 different countries.

There are musicians from the 6 non-EU Western Balkan countries, their neighboring countries and member states of the EU

Underneith Albania, Belgium, BiH, Croatia, Germany, Great Britain, Italy, Kosovo, Lithuania, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Russia, Serbia, Spain and Turkey.

WBYO presents the region's favorite dances, in combination with well-known dances by Brahms, Kodaly, Khachaturian and Shostakovich: Favorite (folk) dances from Albania, BiH Croatia, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia will be arranged by young composers/arrangers from the region as part of the First Open Call for Composition.

After a two weeks preparation phase in Durrës, the symphonic orchestra with 65 young, talented musicians will give concerts in the following Cities:
